

## **Family Alzheimer's In-Home Respite (FAIR)**

### **The Program**

The FAIR program is designed to provide care for individuals with Alzheimer's or a related dementia and give caregivers a needed break.

### **Eligibility**

- \* The person receiving care must have a diagnosis of Alzheimer's disease or a related dementia
- \* There must be an unpaid caregiver
- \* The care must be provided in WV

### **Is there a charge for FAIR services?**

The fee for FAIR services depends upon the income of the person receiving care.

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## West Virginia Aged & Disabled Waiver (ADW) Program

### The Program

The Aged and Disabled Waiver (ADW) program is an in-home care program for individuals who meet the nursing home eligibility level of care, but want to stay in their own home. Personal Attendant staff come to your home to assist with your personal care needs.

You must be at least 18 years of age in order to apply for the ADW program and be a West Virginia resident.

### Eligibility

When you apply for services, a Registered Nurse will contact you for an evaluation in your home.

In order to be eligible, an individual must have needs in at least five areas of activities of daily living. Activities of daily living include the following:

- ☐ Eating
- ☐ Bathing
- ☐ Dressing
- ☐ Grooming
- ☐ Mobility
- ☐ Restroom assistance
- ☐ Other areas of need

To receive ADW services, you must first meet the criteria for both financial and medical eligibility.

## Medicaid Personal Care Program

### The Program

Personal Care (PC) services are available to assist an eligible member to perform activities of daily living (ADLs) and instrumental activities of daily living (IADLs) in the member's home, place of employment or community.

### Eligibility

Applicants for the Personal Care Services Program must meet all of the following criteria to be eligible for the program:

**A.** Be a resident of West Virginia.

The Individual may be discharged or transferred from a nursing home or other institution in any county of the state, or in another state, as long as his/her residence is in West Virginia;

**B.** Be approved as medically eligible as described in this section and its sub-parts;

**C.** Meet Medicaid financial eligibility criteria for the program as determined by the county DHHR office.

In order to be medically eligible, an individual must have needs in at least three areas of activities of daily living. Activities of daily living include the following:

- ◇ Eating
- ◇ Bathing
- ◇ Dressing
- ◇ Grooming
- ◇ Mobility
- ◇ Restroom assistance

## Lighthouse Program

### The Program

The Lighthouse program provides support in four areas:

- **Personal Care:** Grooming, Bathing, Dressing, and Toileting
- **Mobility:** Transferring in/Out of Bed and Walking
- **Nutrition:** Meal preparation, eating, and grocery/pharmacy shopping
- **Environment:** Light housecleaning, making/changing bed, and laundry

### Eligibility

There are three criteria:

- 60+ years of age
- Medically eligible based on a functional evaluation by the senior aging program's RN
- Financially eligible, determined by a sliding fee schedule

### Is there a fee for Lighthouse services?

Yes. The fee for services depends upon the eligible individual's income and is determined by a sliding fee schedule.
